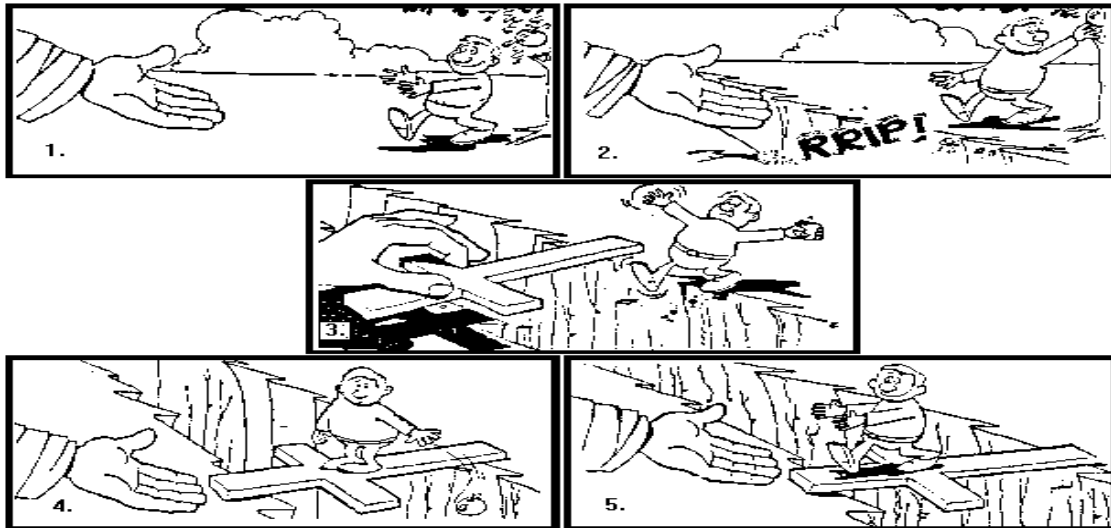


Sharing your Faith with others.

LEADING SOMEONE TO THE LORD



Summary of the pictures:

1. God created us for a relationship with Him – this is the meaning of life. This is our purpose. Acts 17:26-27; Jn.3:16; Jn.17:3
2. Our brokenness (sin) makes a relationship with Him impossible because He is Holy. Isaiah.59:2; Rom.3:23; Rom.1:18
3. We can't become holy by ourselves – only God could bridge the gap. Gal.2:16&21; Joh.14:6; Titus.3:4-5; Rom.5:8; 1Pet.3:18
4. God's hand isn't a stop sign (“uh uh you can't come further until you stop sinning”). We stop sinning out of gratitude for what Jesus did for us. Acts.17:30; 3:19; Acts.16:31; Jn.1:12
5. We enjoy a live full of meaning and purpose in relationship with Him which is what God created us for. Heb.13:5; 1Jn.5:11-13; Col.2:13-14; Gal.5:25

Key Principles:

1. Motivated by love.
2. Make sure you've got it (you can't share a faith you don't have)
3. Win the right to speak by the road of personal friendship
4. Be yourself
5. Use others to help you (1Cor3:6)

Five GROWING habits

- Regular Bible Reading
- Talking to God in Prayer
- Attend church and other meetings of Christians
- Obey the still quiet voice of the Holy Spirit
- Tell others about your faith in Jesus
